


LANGUAGE LEARNING

As we share church and community life, engaging with the peoples of the Middle East, an initial priority is learning language and culture. As our understanding deepens, we grow in love and respect, and relationships develop. We also explore opportunities for ongoing work and service alongside local believers.

TEACHING

Opportunities to contribute to community life in the Middle East through serving with local partners in teaching roles. These include primary and secondary teaching, informal community education, English language teaching, special needs provision, vocational training, university roles, theological education and more. Some focus on refugee communities and other marginalised groups. As we teach and share, we learn and grow!



DEVELOPMENT & COMPASSIONATE MINISTRIES

Opportunities to join with local partners to serve disadvantaged and marginalised communities in the Middle East, including migrants, refugees and the displaced. We affirm dignity and meet practical needs through humanitarian relief, trauma support, vocational training, community education, micro-enterprise schemes and more.

HEALTHCARE

Opportunities to contribute to community life in the Middle East through serving with local partners in healthcare roles. These include positions in hospitals, clinics and community healthcare programmes, as physicians, physiotherapists, dentists, nurses, technicians, trainers and more. Some opportunities have refugee and other marginalised communities as a specific focus.

BUSINESS

Opportunities to serve communities in the Middle East through business or in economic development roles, using professional skills to contribute to our host countries. Working alongside local partners, we model integrity and business best practice, provide coaching and mentoring, and grow in our own professional skills.

BRINGING HOPE

As we use our professional skills to serve local communities, we build relationships to bring encouragement and hope.

We long for those without hope to find fulfilment in Christ.
